CATHOLIC MINISTRIES DRIVE (formerly known as the Annual Catholic Appeal) has now begun. While each parish is asked to achieve a "target" amount, unlike other years the parish will not be assessed if its target is not reached. *The target amount for St. Francis of Assisi is \$18,608.00 which breaks down to \$59.26 per family*. Contributions exceeding the target will be refunded to the parish. Total received as of May 31: 49 of 314 families contributed \$5,835.25 which is 31% of our goal.

VISITNG MISSIONARY – Fr. Geejo V.C., a Vincentian Missionary Priest from India, will be in our Parish on June 17 and 18 to participate in our Annual Missionary Cooperation Plan. He will share his missionary experience at all our Masses next weekend and will make an appeal on behalf of the Vincentian Missions. The Vincentian Congregation (V.C.), a Religious Congregation, was founded in Kerala, India in 1904, modeled after the Congregation of the Mission founded by St. Vincent de Paul. Members of this flourishing

Religious Congregation are engaged in Mission Work in all parts of India and in East Africa and Peru. The Vincentian Missionaries need our help to carry out their many missionary, educational and charitable activities. They need our special financial support for the training of young men studying for the Priesthood. There will be a special Mission collection next weekend (June 17 & 18) to help the Missionary work of the Vincentian Fathers. Please keep Fr. Geejo Pattah and the Vincentian Missionaries in your prayers. Envelopes for this collection are included with the bulletin.

Liturgical Reflection...The Church enjoys a new ritual for the celebration of Marriage. The revised *Order of Celebrating Matrimony* became the official Rite in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown during the Advent Season of this liturgical year. The revised rite replaced the 1969 Ritual issued after the Second Vatican Council. The revisions of the celebration of Sacramental Marriage will be reviewed during the summer months. The Church celebrates with all couples who prepare and celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage.
